

Phil was a senior scientist at Sylvania (later GTE), and Jan did good works for various community groups, tutored foreigners, wrote a guidebook for newcomers to the area, and herded children. From time to time she was among the pick-up crew which would clean, paint, etc. when club funds were low, and she joined with a few other members to shop for sturdy and appropriate clubhouse furniture. The children learned to swim, grew up, and moved on to other activities (one became a civil engineer, and the other won the Nobel Prize in Medicine in 2006). Jan continues to enjoy swimming at Fairbrae, and it is rumored that her tattered Speedo bathing suit, now retired, is on display at the Smithsonian Hall of Aquatic Curiosities.
