POOL RULE NO. 9 AMENDED

Due to feedback from membership, we have amended pool Rule 9.
Rule 9 now reads: *"No personal floatation devices (i.e: water wings or lifejackets) without direct supervision of a guardian(in the water, within arm's reach)."*

Please help us keep Fairbrae safe by following our pool rules and regulations!

POOL USAGE FAQ

There have been many questions lately regarding pool usage. Here is a quick FAQ regarding how we keep our pool safe!

I would like to use the deep end, but there are no guards on duty! Can I use the deep end?

Yes. You may use the deep end. Parents must maintain supervision over their kids in the water at all times, and this extends to deep end use!

I've noticed that "Adult Swim" doesn't get called anymore. What's the deal?

In an effort to keep the pool open for the kids, we have been skipping "Adult Swim" when we have enough guards on staff to keep the pool open for the kids. However, as fair compromise to adults who would like to use the pool without distraction, members may request "Adult Swim" at the top of the hour by notifying the lifeguards.

Can I use the diving boards if there are no guards on duty?

No. Under no circumstances should the diving board be used without lifeguard supervision.

I've noticed some other members are having a pool party. That sounds like fun! I'd like to have some friends over and have a party of my own, how would I go about doing that?

Please contact the Fairbrae front office for any outdoor/pool party requests! We try to limit the number of parties running at the same time to keep Fairbrae enjoyable for both the parties and its members!

We're having a pool party, and it's really annoying having to keep answering the front door for my guests. Can we prop the door open?

Unfortunately, no. Since we have a pool, California Law requires closed gate access to our facility at all times. Additionally, it removes the barrier to entry for uninvited guests into our club! Thanks for understanding!

TENNIS COURT COURTESIES

Please follow these guidelines to keep our courts clean and free of problems!

- No kids under 12 without direct supervision.
- The tennis courts are for tennis players only! (No skateboarding, biking, skating)
- Use equipment properly (ball tubes, squeegees, ball machine, score cards, etc.)
- No food, gum or glass containers allowed inside the tennis courts.
- Players may make reservations online at : http://www.supersaas.com/schedule/Fairbrae/Tennis_Courts
- If no reservations are made, the tennis courts are first come, first serve.
- Players must wear appropriate attire on the courts.
- Must wear close-toed sneakers with non marking soles when playing.
- Members' guests must be signed into the Guest Logbook.
- The club provides a ball machine for use by adult members or juniors supervised by an adult. The ball machine should not be used when the other court is occupied, unless the occupants of the other court agree to its use.
- Evening players are responsible for turning off stadium lights when done.
- Use ball recycle bin by water fountain for old/dead balls only, not trash bins

SUMMER MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Here are some updates on a few of the ongoing projects we have going on at the club:

- **Treefall Update:** The neighbor's tree has had a lot of mass removed to help keep weight off major limbs. In addition, we have removed the damaged playground and fencing from the affected area. A section of our perimeter fence has been repaired, and will be painted at a later time, when the wood has cured.
- **Playground Area Progress:** We are currently taking an informal survey with opinions on what to do with the former playground area. If you would like to share your opinion, please email alex@fairbrae.com with your suggested use. A formal meeting will be held at a later date to further involve membership in this decision.
- **Crow's Nest Stairs Repair:** We are currently in discussions with a few different commercial architects and engineers to approve our drawings for stairs repair. Once our drawings are approved by the city, we will move forward with repairs. On that note, we are also seeking referrals to architects with commercial experience.
- **Pool Lights:** The two broken pool lamp brackets have been repaired. One of the brackets suffered structural damage to the insertion location and will require drilling into the pool shell to fix. According to the Genie Pools, the damage could have only occurred if someone "intentionally" pulled up on the light. We currently have an adapter installed that is keeping the light in place, however the long-term fix will require draining the entire pool in the off-season. Please take care when swimming in the pool, and please do not touch the lights!



POOL RULES

Warm weather means pool weather! Let's all follow the rules to make sure that we can continue to enjoy Fairbrae for generations to come!

GENERAL POOL RULES

1. No running on the pool deck.
2. No horseplay.
3. No hanging on the lane lines.
4. No glass in the pool area.
5. No "rough housing" or "horseplay". This includes no pushing or dunking.
6. "Swim diapers" must be worn by all children who are not toilet trained. This policy applies to both pools.
7. No food or gum in the pool.
8. Children should be supervised by an adult if lifeguards are not present.
9. No personal floatation devices (i.e: water wings or lifejackets) without direct supervision of a guardian (in the water, within arm's reach).
10. No headfirst diving permitted anywhere in the pool.
11. No open sores/wounds in the pool.
12. Please shower before entering the pool.

DIVING BOARD RULES

1. The diving board is off-limits unless a lifeguard or other Fairbrae staff is present.
2. Only one person on the diving board at a time.
3. Only one bounce is permitted on the board.
4. No flips of any kind are allowed off of the diving board.
5. Only jump off the front of the board facing toward the water.
6. Wait for the lifeguard's signal before diving off of the board.
7. When the diving board is in use, the diving well is off-limits to swimmers.

POOL COVER POLICY

1. Fairbrae is a self-service facility! If necessary, please carefully remove ALL pool covers before using the pool.
2. If possible, please replace the pool covers at night, as this helps keep the utility bills down!

The lifeguards and club management team have complete authority – vested by the Board of Directors – in the pool area. Please respect the rules and be safe!
