APPENDIX D

FAIRBRAE TENNIS RULES

1. Adult members (18 years or older) can make court reservations at 6:00 pm up to two and a half days in advance, as follows:

Any reservations made further in advance than the above may be erased by the club manager or any board member, and the court will then be available again for normal reservations.

2. Junior members (less than 18 years old playing without an adult may only book courts between 3:30 pm and 5:30 pm Monday through Friday. Between these times, court 2 is reserved for exclusive use by juniors and court 1 is open for reservations by juniors or adults.

Adults may play with juniors between 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm weekdays, and 3:00 pm through 10:00 pm on Sundays.

Juniors can reserve courts before 3:30 pm on weekdays that have not been reserved by 3 hours before playing time.

3. Members of the same playing group can not reserve consecutive court session in advance, but may continue to play if the next session is not reserved or the next session is forfeited under rule 4.
4. A minimum of two players must occupy the court within ten minutes of the reserved starting time or the reservation is forfeit and the court becomes available for anyone to use.
5. Members must erase their names from the booking sheet if they are unable to use the court.

6. Club officials can reserve courts as needed for Interclub matches, tournaments, tennis lessons, or any other club-sponsored events. Members reserving courts following these events must wait for the event to finish before occupying their court.
7. Players must wear appropriate attire on the courts. Shoes must have non-marking rubber soles.
8. Members may play with guests on payment of the current guest fee. members must complete a guest registration slip each time they play with a guest.
9. The club provides a ball machine for use by adult members or juniors supervised by an adult. Use of the ball machine is subject to a fee. members must sign the registration form on the inside of the ball machine locker door so that the fee can be billed on their monthly statement.

The ball machine cannot be used when the other court is occupied unless the occupants of the other court agree to its use.

10. The board may change these rules at any time and they are subject to the club's By-Laws and general rules.
